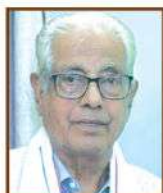

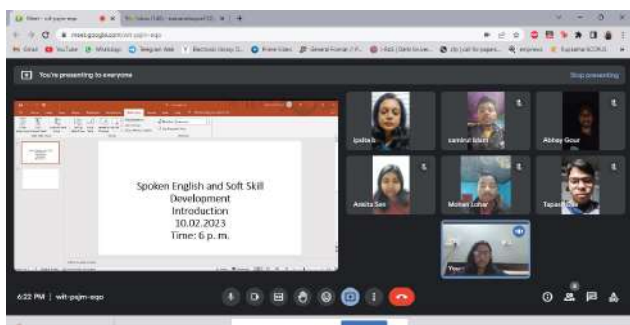

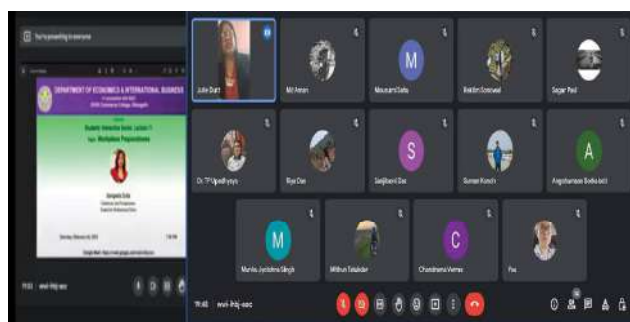
36. The members of Gender Champion Club performed a drama on the topic “Feminism is not fake it’s confusing” in the college on 30th January, 2023.

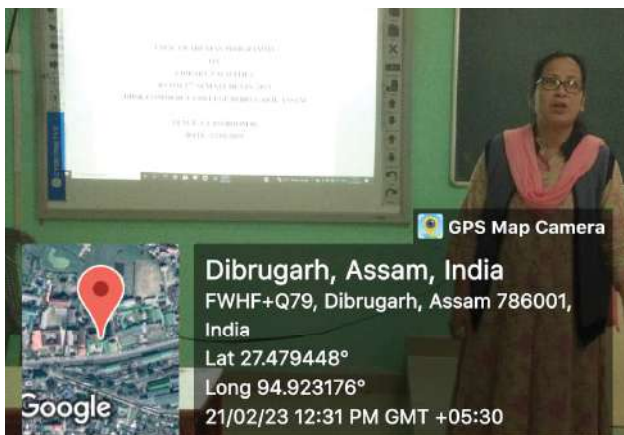

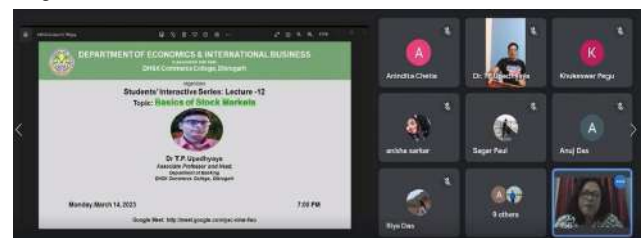

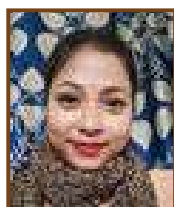
